Cookies

What are cookies?

Cookies are small, often encrypted, text files, which are stored on your computer when you visit some websites. They are used to remember useful information which allows certain functionality within the website to work. Cookies can't harm your computer.

How long do cookies last?

Cookies last for different lengths of time depending on what they are used for.

- Session cookies are temporary cookies and are only stored until you leave the website or when you close your web browser.
- Persistent cookies last for a fixed period of time, defined within the cookie, and allow the website to recognise the device again when the user returns to that website on that device.

Who sets the cookie?

- First party cookies – these are set by the website that you are visiting and can only be read by that website.
- Third party cookies – these are set by an organisation other than the owner of the website. This might be for the purposes of website measurement, being able to watch a video on the site or for the purposes of advertising.

Cookies used on the Disabled Ramblers website

First party cookies:

- wfv_ Information about your general geographic location
SET BY Wordfence Security plugin
LASTS a few days
- wordfence_verifiedHuman
Differentiates between a web browser and an automated script that is viewing the web site. Password cracking bots use scripts
SET BY Wordfence Security plugin
LASTS a few days

Registered Charity Number 1103508

- Cookie “__EC_TEST__”
Differentiates between desktop computer and tablet/phone.
SET BY WordPress
LASTS until the browser is closed

Third party cookies:

Only the embedded YouTube videos set third party cookies. The following are set when you start the video.

- PREF - Expires after 8 months
- VISITOR_INFO1_LIVE - expires after 8 months
- VSC - expires at the end of your session
- remote sid - expires at the end of your session
